
Overview

Vendor PayPal Adaptive Add-on is a payment distribution module for CedCommerce Multivendor Marketplace extension. The basic version of CedCommerce Multivendor Marketplace allows the admin to manually pay to the vendor, but, using this add-on the payment can be split between the site owner and multiple vendors simultaneously. Whenever a buyer makes payment for the products purchased by him/her then, the amount for the merchant and the admin are calculated and their respective amounts are credited to their accounts. The buyer need not have a PayPal account in this case.

The payment will be dispatched to the vendor of the product, and, the product commission to the merchant directly. To use this module, you must have CedCommerce Multivendor Marketplace extension installed first.

Configure PayPal Adaptive Payment

The website admin can manage the PayPal adaptive extension configuration by going to System > Configuration menu in the admin panel.



When you click on the above configuration link you will see the following fields. It will show you the PayPal Adaptive Payment section, through which you can configure easily and send the payment directly to the vendors.

Below you can see some of the fields that should be filled with unique information. We have explained the information about the fields below.


i. Payment Type

There are two payment types: **Parallel** and **Chained**.


Both payments types have their own significance. Here is a quick view on both the payment types.

a) Parallel Payment

Parallel payment method is quite popular payment method for PayPal adaptive. Suppose there is a customer who bought items related to both Vendor 1 and Vendor 2, and then when the customer makes the payment using the PayPal adaptive payment method, he/she will be able to see the payment being divided between the vendors and the Admin.



However, the Parallel payment method allows dividing the payment among 10 people at maximum which is a big restriction in the Parallel PayPal adaptive payment method.




b) Chained Payment

Chained payment method is another popular payment method for PayPal. In chained payment method when customer makes the payment he/she sees only one receiver and then in the backend process the receiver divides the payment and dispatches the payment to the vendors. Chained payment method further gets divided in two sections: -

Instant Chained Payment-


In the instant chained payment method, the payment is divided instantly by the admin as soon as he/she receives the payment from the customer.




In the above chained payment diagram you can see that the payment is directly sent to the primary receivers and as the primary receiver gets the payment, it further splits instantly and goes to the vendors automatically.

Delayed Chained Payment-

Delayed chained payment is an advanced working flow of the instant chained payment. Suppose there is a merchant who wants to sustain the payment which he/she receives, to himself/herself and dispatch the payment only when the product is delivered to the customer. Then in this case the Delayed payment method works. In effect the Delayed payment method allows the merchant to hold and sustain the amount of the payment released, when he wants to.



When the customer makes the payment to the merchant, the merchant sees an extra tab, available in the order area which allows him/her to release the payment to the vendor.



When payment is made using the Delayed Chained payment method then an extra tab named "PayPal Adaptive" will be shown in the order area. When the merchant clicks on the "Release Payment" then the payment is released to the vendors.

ii. Merchant PayPal associated Email Id

This will require entering the email id of the merchant. Please note that only the merchant will be the primary receiver in case of the chained payment method.

iii. PayPal Application ID

Here it will require entering the PayPal application id when you are fetching the information of the PayPal credential. By default, the PayPal application id of the merchant will be “APP-80W284485P519543T” so, use this application id for the PayPal adaptive payment methods.

iv. PayPal API User Name

Please enter the PayPal API username here as you might have already done for other PayPal payment method setups.

v. PayPal API Password

Please enter the PayPal API password here as you might have done for other PayPal payment method setups.

vi. PayPal API Signature

Please enter the PayPal API signature here as you might have done for other PayPal payment method setups.

vii. Sandbox Mode

If you want to set the payment mode as testing then, set the sandbox mode to ‘yes’ and test your setup properly, activate your shop with PayPal adaptive.

viii. Title

Please set the any title you want to show on the customer checkout process.
